Personnel Complaint

SECTION 37.02, PERJURY. THE TEXAS PENAL CODE OF 1973: “(a) A person commits an offense if, with intent to deceive and with knowledge of the statement’s meaning:

1) he/she makes false statement under oath or swears to the truth of false statement previously made; and

2) the statement is required or authorized by law to be made under oath.

(b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor. “(Punishment for a Class A misdemeanor A fine of not more than \$4,000.00 or a jail term of not more than one year, or both fine and imprisonment)
