ORDINANCE NO. 18-25

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FORNEY, TEXAS, ALTERING THE PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED FOR VEHICLES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF TRANSPORTATION CODE, SECTION 545.356 UPON SOUTH BOIS D'ARC STREET OR PARTS THEREOF, WITHIN THE INCORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF FORNEY, AS SET OUT IN THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING A PENALTY OF A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$200.00 FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, Section 545.356 of the Texas Transportation Code, provides that whenever the governing body of the City shall determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that any prima facie speed therein set forth is greater or less than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist at any intersection or other place or upon any part of a street or highway within the City, taking into consideration the width and condition of the pavement and other circumstances on such portion of said street or highway, as well as the usual traffic thereon, said governing body may determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit thereat or thereon by the passage of an ordinance, which shall be effective when appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected at such intersection or other place or part of the street or highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORNEY, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. RECITALS

The Council hereby finds that the statements set forth in the recitals of this Ordinance are true and correct, and the Council hereby incorporates such recitals as part of this Ordinance.

Section 2. PRIMA FACIE SPEED LIMITS

Upon the basis of a finding by the City Council of the City of Forney that the existing speed limits on South Bois D'Arc Street from Broad Street to College Avenue are unreasonable or unsafe heretofore made as authorized by the provisions of Transportation Code, Section 545.356(b-1), the following prima facie speed limits hereafter indicated for vehicles are hereby determined and declared to be reasonable and safe; and such speed limits are hereby fixed at the rate of speed indicated for vehicles traveling upon the named streets and highways, or parts thereof, described as follows:

That from and after the date of the passage of this speed zone ordinance, no motor vehicle shall be operated along and upon South Bois D'Arc Street from Broad Street to College Avenue within the corporate limits of the City of Forney in excess of 30 MPH.

Section 3. AUTHORITY TO ERECT SIGNS

The Mayor of Forney is hereby authorized to cause to be erected, appropriate signs indicating such speed zones.

Section 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Council that the words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Ordinance are severable, and if any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this Zoning Ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the Council without the incorporation of any such unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

Section 5. SAVINGS CLAUSE

The Code of Ordinances shall be and remain in full force and effect save and except as amended by this Ordinance.

Section 6. REPEALER CLAUSE

Any provision of any prior ordinance of the City, whether codified or uncodified, which is in conflict with any provision of this Ordinance, is hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict, but all other provisions of the ordinances of the City, whether codified or uncodified, which are not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 7. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law and Charter in such cases provide.

Section 8. PENALTY

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).
