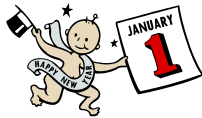

### Water Conservation

#### Stage 3 Watering Restrictions

**No landscape and lawn irrigation is allowed from 10 AM to 6 PM**

Stage 3 restrictions limit landscape watering with sprinklers or irrigation systems to once every two weeks. For a listing of your designated watering days, ways to conserve and other guidelines and restrictions go to [www.cityofforney.org](http://www.cityofforney.org).

The restrictions prohibit using water in such a manner as to allow runoff or other waste. The restrictions also prohibit washing or rinsing of vehicles with a hose unless it has a cutoff nozzle.

Exceptions are as follows: Foundations, new landscaping, new plantings (first year) of shrubs, and trees may be watered for up to 2 hours on any day by a hand-held hose, a soaker hose, or a dedicated zone using a drip irrigation system.

Also included in the Stage 3 provisions, the NTMWD Member Cities and Customers must continue to meet or exceed the 10% water use reduction goal.
