**Update on the construction of FM740 Bridge  
 over Buffalo Creek**

Darwin Myers of TxDOT advises that construction is proceeding well. One side of the bridge is in place and they are working on the other side. Completion is anticipated in the Fall of 2011.

Crews have worked overnight several times to install some of the US80/FM548 bridge beams. The beams are extremely heavy and this is dangerous work. Please use extra caution when driving in the construction zones.
